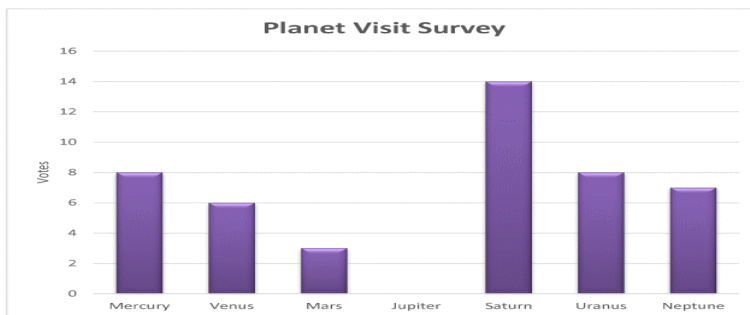

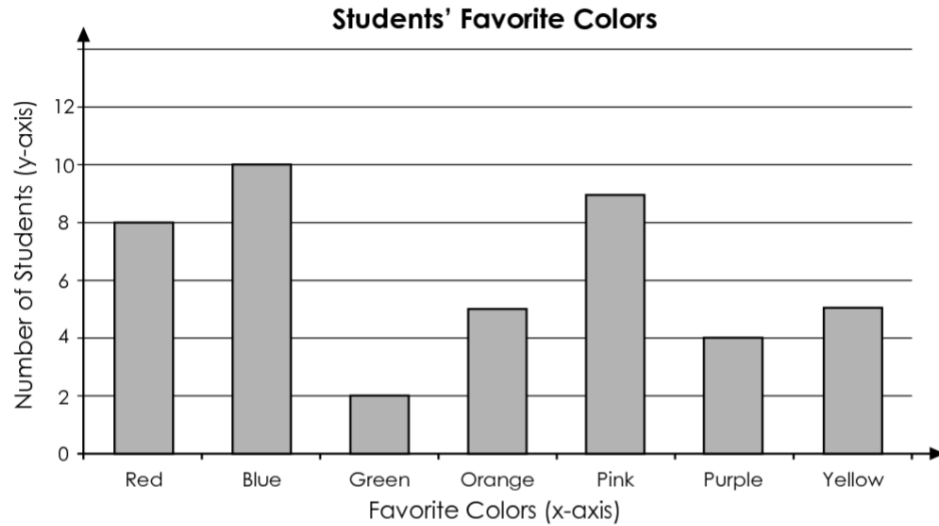

LIFESTYLE & CULTURE OF JAPAN

The people of Japan call their country "Nippon", which means "The land of the rising sun". You can see the rising sun in the middle of their flag.

PEOPLE

- Most Japanese people today wear western style clothes.
- But during holidays, festivals and other special times, they may wear traditional Robes called **Kimonos**.

- The pattern of kimonos changes with the season to reflect the seasonal changes with nature.
- In Japan it is polite to greet one another by bowing.

CULTURE

Japanese culture has made some important contributions to the world.

- **Ikebana** is the art of flower arranging.
- **Bonsai** is the cultivation of miniature trees.
- **Origami** is the art of paper folding.
- **Haiku** is a type of Japanese poetry.

FOOD

- Rice is the important crop in Japan. It is served at almost every meal in Japan.
- Another staple is fish, which is the main source of protein.
- A popular dish is sushi, which is rice and raw fish wrapped in sea-weed.

FESTIVALS

- The **cherry blossom festival** or **Hanami** is the time for celebration in the spring. People gathered in the park to view the cherry blossom (called **Sakura**)
- In **Setsubun** families throw beans (usually soybean) in mame-maki ceremonies to drive away evil spirits that could foul up things later. One member of the household dons a demon mask and plays the “bad guy” as everyone else shouts “get out” and throw beans until he leaves.
- Awa Odori is the largest traditional dance festival in Japan. Everybody wears summer cotton kimono and straw hats and dance on almost all the streets in Tokushima City, from the 12th to the 15th of August.

SPORTS

- Basketball is one of the most popular sports
- Wrestling is National Sport of Japan.

CLIMATE

- It has a humid monsoon climate.
- Autumn and spring paint the region in the brilliant colors of red, yellow, green and such making it a splendid sight to view.
- During winter, Japan witness icy winds and snow.
- Around 3 quarters of the Japanese land is mountains and forests.
- The land of Japan is frequently hit by natural disasters like earthquakes and tsunamis.
- Japan suffers 1500 earthquakes every year.
