Nani and Vikas have to walk down the Lane of Magic to reach the park.

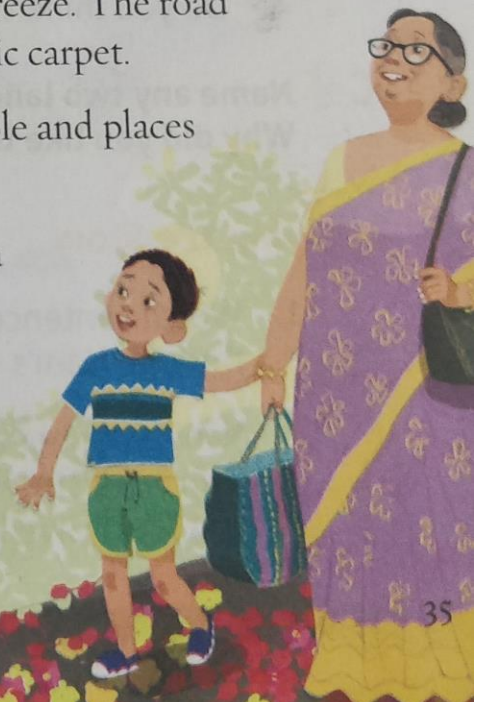
Vikas looks up at the big, shady trees, and feels a cool breeze. The road is covered in red and yellow flowers. It looks like a magic carpet.

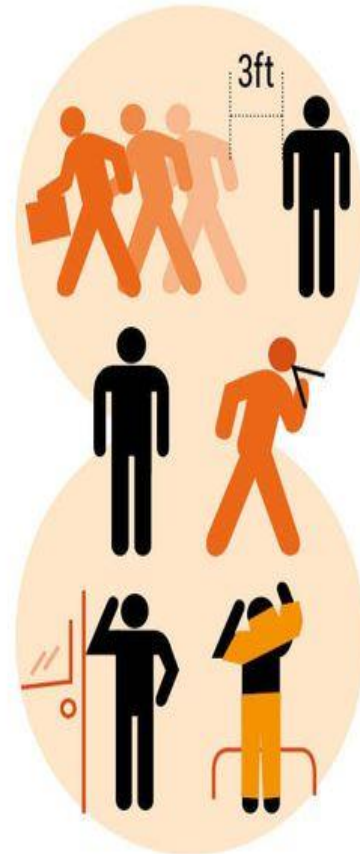

PRECAUTIONS AT PUBLIC PLACES

Social distancing

- Maintaining a distance of three feet or one metre from people around is another prudent step to ward off catching an infection, said Dr. Atul Anant Aundhekar, general practitioner and CEO of Avivo Group.

DO'S

-  Unless urgent don't go out to market and public places
-  Maintain 2 meter physical distance at bus stop, vegetable or grocery shop, hospital
-  Take help of 104 or telemedicine instead of frequently visiting to hospitals
-  Use mask when going out
-  Wait in a queue in patience

DONT'S

-  Don't spit in public place
-  Don't touch mouth, nose and eye
-  Don't believe rumour on COVID
-  Don't go to gathering
-  Don't shake hands or come in close contact with others
