We use 'a' before common nouns which are in singular in number and begin with a consonant sound.

EXAMPLES: a boy, a bag, a toy

We say 'a utensil' because it begins with a consonant sound



We use 'an' before common nouns which are singular in number, and begin with a vowel sound.

EXAMPLE: We say 'an honest man' because 'honest' begins with a vowel sound 'o' as in orange, So we put 'an' before 'honest.' (The letter 'h' is silent in the word 'honest'.)

- 1. Article 'the' is used for particular persons and things. For example: 'the Earth'.
- 2. We use 'a' and 'an' when we talk of any person or thing.

EXAMPLES: a. Give me a book.(any book)

b. Give me the book you are reading.(a particular book)

- A/an is used when we are speaking of something for the first time.
- The is used when we are speaking of the same thing in the following sentences.
