





Sentence 1) expresses an action in the present time and is in the present tense.

Sentence 2) expresses an action in the past time and is in the **past tense**.

Sentence 3) expresses an action that is likely to take place in the future and is in the **future** tense.

THE VERB 'HAVE'

I	have	I	had	I	shall have/will have
we	have	we	had	we	shall have/will have
you	have	you	had	you	will have
he, she ,it	have	he, she it	had	he	will have
they	have	they	had	she	will have
			had	it	will have
				they	will have

Shall/Will

- We use 'shall' only with 'I' and 'we'.
 With all other pronouns we use 'will'.
