A preposition is a word placed before a noun or pronoun to show in what relation the person stands in regard to something else.

Generally, the preposition is placed before its object.

A) Prepositions of Time:

We use prepositions of time to show 'time' or 'when' something happens.

at	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an exact time • a specific age • festivals, weekend • parts of the day 	e.g., at 6 a.m. at eighteen at Diwali at night
on	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a named day/date • a named part of a day 	e.g., on Monday, on 17th June on Friday night
in	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a named month/ year • a century or season • parts of the day 	e.g., in June, in 2002 in summer, in spring, in 21st century in the morning
before	• earlier than something	e.g., before lunch, before evening
after	• later than something	e.g., after breakfast

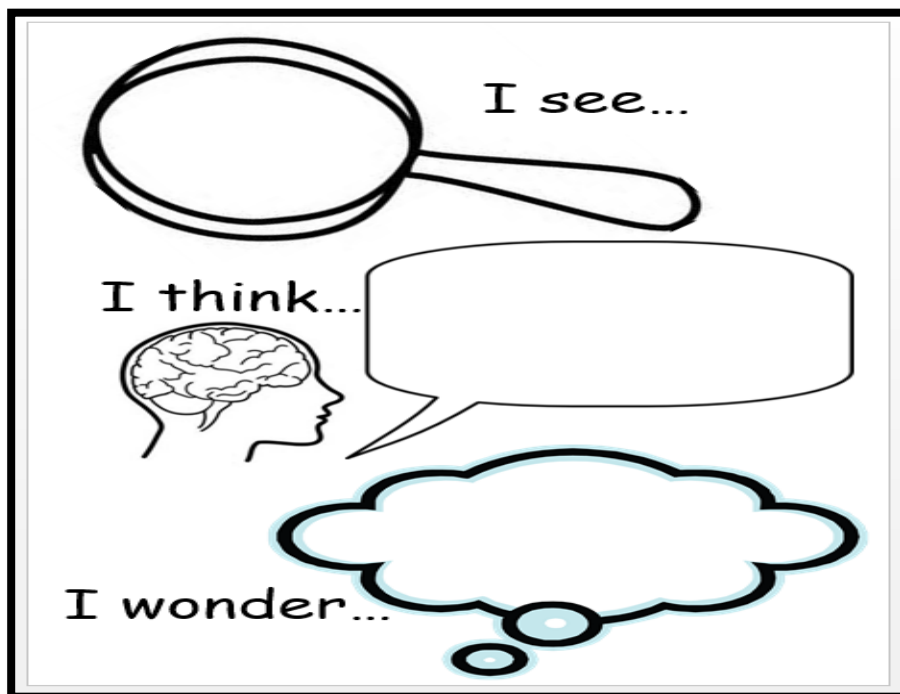
