Prepositions

Prepositions are a part of speech that allow the formation of relationships between nouns or pronouns and other words in a sentence. They tell us if the words are related by **place, direction, time or purpose.**

Examples :

- i. Meet me **in** the class.
- ii. Keep the plates **on** the table.

Words like **in, into, on, of, across, under, above, behind, near, with, through, over, by and between** are prepositions.

Prepositions of Place

Prepositions of place show the position of someone or something in relation to the other people or things.

Mohan lives **in** Nagpur.

Come and sit **beside** me.

Wait for me **at** the school gate.

Keep the box **on** the shelf

Preposition of Direction and movement

Prepositions of direction show the direction of a person or a thing in relation to the other people or things.

Examples:

He is going **towards** Ajmer

I was sitting **between** my parents

I sat **beside** my friend
