Symbol is a visual mark that is used to represent a message and is socially accepted by the majority.

Symbols convey messages without spoken or written words.

Types of Symbols

- pictogram (pictograph)
-



Pictograms are public symbols, they are used to convey information through their resemblance to a physical object or place.

There is no connection between the spoken word and the object pictured. A pictogram recalls the object or concept itself to mind, not its name.

That's what makes pictograms international.

Pictograms represent objects and places

- icon
-



Icons represent objects and their functions.

The name of a function (computer program, app) is substituted with a symbol that is recognizable and logical.

The most common use of icons is on digital devices.

Icons represent objects and/or their functions.

- logo

Logo is a type of symbol used to represent a brand and to promote products and services.

Logo's job is to quickly identify and tell the story about a company, a service, a product, an idea, or an individual.

Logo is a *unique* symbol that identifies a company.

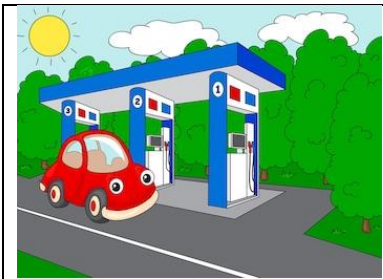
