Advantages and Disadvantages of Exploration For the Natives of the places explored

Advantages

- New, more advanced items such as kettles, blankets, rings etc. The natives were exposed to various items which were new to them and beyond their capacity to think and imagine. Such things were both useful and simple to operate. As a result, the natives soon became accustomed to such items and adopted them in their life-style
- Friendships with other countries The nations came close together and formed alliances for the mutual benefit for each of their residents
- Trade The trade grew between the nations providing extra income and resources to both the parties

<u>Disadvantages</u>

- Slavery Exploitation of the local population was the worst thing which happened due to the exploration. They were taken to the other nation and sold as slaves
- Torture and slaughter The locals were subjected to torture and slaughter at the hands of the explorers, who had better arms and money power.
- Loss of religion and native language The explorers brought their own religion to the explored nation and tried to force it onto the local residents. Use of English in India is a perfect example.
- Not trading equally at times As the explorers had more power with them, the trading was generally one sided, where the explorers gained the most.
- Loss of their land to explorers and settlers The explorers acquired the land of the native population to settle down to expand their influence and business.

FOR THE EXPLORERS

Advantages

- Gaining land The explorers established their supremacy by acquiring the land and establishing their factories/businesses in the native place. Hence, they were able to expand their business and empire to many countries
- Fame Such explorers gained name and fame while discovering new places and bringing the wealth and goods from different countries across the world.
- More power for their countries As their empire spread in other countries, their own countries became more powerful and strong.
- Opportunity to spread beliefs The explorers spread their religion, culture and beliefs across the world to other nations.
- Adventure and experience The explorers enjoyed the adventure of travelling around the world in big ships and gained a variety of experience, meeting different people, exploring their culture and enjoying different types of food.

Disadvantages

- Attacked by natives at times–Many times the explorers were attacked by the natives taking them as oppressors, who have come to steal their belongings.
- Danger The exploration in those times 300 years back was not an easy task. The explorers travelled in wooden ships and were exposed to dangers of bad weather, pirates etc. Due to which there was an immense amount of danger involved in such explorations.
- Failure There was a big risk of failure of the exploration due to the dangers involved.
- Waste of money if failed With each failed mission big amount of money was often wasted.
