## COORDINATING CONJUNCTIONS

CONJUNCTION	EXAMPLE
<b>For</b>	We listened eagerly, <b>for</b> he brought news of our families.
<b>And</b>	She didn't speak to anyone, <b>and</b> nobody spoke to her.
<b>Nor</b>	I don't expect children to be rude, <b>nor</b> do I expect to be disobeyed.
<b>But</b>	They rushed to the hospital, <b>but</b> they were too late.
<b>Or</b>	I will go shopping, <b>or</b> I will go camping.
<b>Yet</b>	Kelly was a convicted criminal, <b>yet</b> many people admired him.
<b>So</b>	I was feeling hungry, <b>so</b> I made myself a sandwich.

# Maths

## Measurement (Capacity)

Capacity means the amount that something can hold.

Usually it means volume, such as millilitres (ml) or litres (l) in Metric.

We measure the capacity of all the liquid objects.

Example: This glass has a capacity of 300 ml (but is actually holding only 160 ml)



There are various tools to measure the capacity.

The vessel shown below measures 1 litre of petrol or kerosene.




1 litre

This vessel when filled completely measures one litre of the liquid. The other measures for measuring petrol, kerosene etc. are given below.



500 mL      200 mL      100 mL      50 mL

The vessels for measuring milk are shown below.



1 litre      500 mL      200 mL      100 mL      50 mL

## Units of Liquid Measure

Litre and millilitre are two popular units of liquid measure.

$$1 \text{ litre} = 1000 \text{ millilitres}$$

"1 litre" is written 'in short' as 1 L; and "1 millilitre" as 1 ml.

$$1 \text{ L} = 1000 \text{ ml}$$



**Carnival of Venice-** Carnival of Venice is celebrated 40 days before Easter in Italy. Each year thousands of tourists and locals take to the streets in beautiful costumes and masks to enjoy music, dance, and the festive atmosphere in beautiful costumes and masks.



### **La Tomatina**

**Every year this festival is celebrated on last Wednesday of August in Spain.** La Tomatina is the friendly food fight festival held every August in the town of Buñol. The hour long battle begins with the firing of water cannons, which is followed with over 100 tons of

over-ripe tomatoes being squashed and flung all over.

### **Balloon Festival**

The Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta is the largest annual international event held in first or second week of October in the US. Colourful hot air balloons glide through the crisp fall air. Laser light shows, fireworks, live band performances and interactive education complete the magic at Balloon Fiesta.



## Lantern Festival

Yi Peng or Lantern Festival is held annually as festival of lights in Northern Thailand. During this time local homes and public places are decked in colourful hanging lanterns and flag decorations.

Festivities include a parade, live music and dance shows, handicraft sessions, and releasing lanterns into the night sky. It is commonly believed that releasing lanterns symbolizes letting go of past misfortune and making a clean start.



## Halloween Festivals

Halloween is celebrated each year on October 31. People light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts. The evening before was known as All Hallows Eve, and later Halloween.
