Lines of Inquiry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● How we choose to act in different situations (Perspective) ● Impact of our actions (Connection) ● My conduct speaks about me (Reflection)
Key Concepts	<p><u>Perspective</u> – They will understand that our actions are driven by different perspectives.</p> <p><u>Connection</u> – They will be able to understand and make a connection that their actions affect others.</p> <p><u>Responsibility</u>- They will build up understanding that their behavior is the expression of their manners.</p>
Learner Profiles	<p><u>Principled</u>- Learn to take responsibility for their actions and their consequences.</p> <p><u>Reflective</u>- They will thoughtfully consider their own ideas and experiences.</p> <p><u>Balanced</u>- They will learn to take care of mind, body and feelings.</p>
ATL Skills	<p><u>Social</u>-They will learn to react reasonably to the situation and accept responsibility of their own behaviour.</p> <p><u>Self-management</u> –Know and apply codes of behavior and choose an appropriate course of action.</p>


