8 Common and Proper Nouns

A Common and Proper Nouns
The word *car* is a **common noun**. It is a *noun* because it is a naming word. It is a *common noun* because we can use it for any car, whether it is a Maruti, a Honda, or a Ford. *Maruti*, *Honda* and *Ford* are special names for a car. Special names are called **proper nouns**. The words *cousin* and *city* are common nouns. The words *Ankita* and *Chennai* are proper nouns.


▶ **Common nouns** are the names given to persons, animals, places or things which are of the same kind.
▶ **Proper nouns** are the special names given to persons, animals (usually pets), places or things.

Towns and cities	: Mathura, Chennai
Countries	: France, New Zealand
Rivers	: Mahanadi, Brahmaputra
Buildings	: Gateway of India, Eiffel Tower
Days and months	: Sunday, April
Special days	: Independence Day, Environment Day
Festivals	: Holi, Id, Christmas
Newspapers	: <i>The Times of India</i> , <i>Hindustan Times</i>
Books	: <i>The Jungle Book</i> , <i>Gulliver's Travels</i>
Goods	: Samsung, Parker

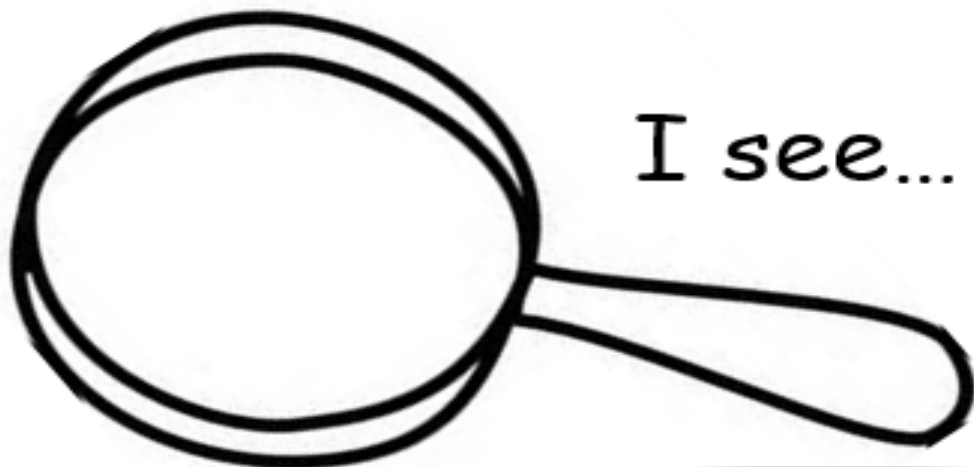
