

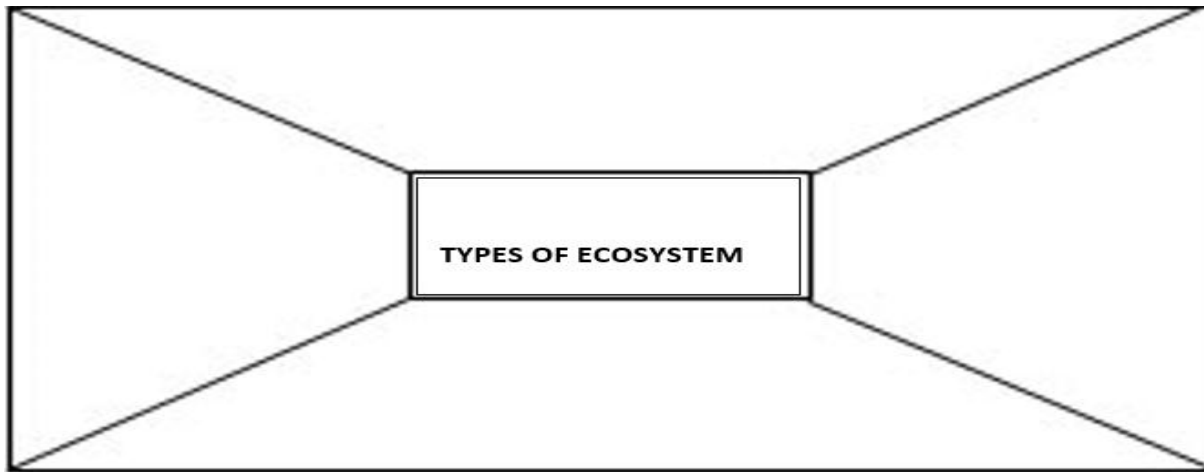
SORTING OUT

Neermahal is the former royal palace of Tripura and one of the two water palaces and the second largest of its kind in India after Jal Mahal in Rajasthan.

Unakoti Hill is a place of worship with huge rock-cut images and stone idols of Lord Shiva.

Namchi is famous for its Buddhist monastery and has the statue of **Guru Rinpoche**, the tallest statue of the saint in the world.
