When looking for the source of a conflict, it's important to remember that the different types of conflict reflect where the conflict originates (internally or externally) and the number of people involved (personal or group).


In particular, four types of conflict are common-

THE 4 TYPES OF CONFLICT

Person vs. Person	Person vs. Self	Person vs. Nature	Person vs. Society
An <u>external</u> conflict That involves a <u>mental</u> or physical struggle between <u>two</u> Characters in a story.	An <u>internal</u> conflict that involves the struggle between the character and his/her conscience /self.	An <u>external</u> conflict that involves a struggle between the <u>elements</u> of nature that are beyond his/her control.	An <u>external</u> conflict that involves the struggle between the character and the <u>rules</u> or <u>laws</u> that govern the society in which he/she lives.
EXAMPLE: A husband and wife disagree about how their money should be spent	EXAMPLE: A teenager is torn between ditching school with her friends and staying to do the review before the test in a class she is failing.	EXAMPLE: A family is stranded in a snow storm.	EXAMPLE: A teenager breaks a driving law by running a red light.


