When looking for the source of a conflict, it's important to remember that the different types of conflict reflect where the conflict originates (internally or externally) and the number of people involved (personal or group).

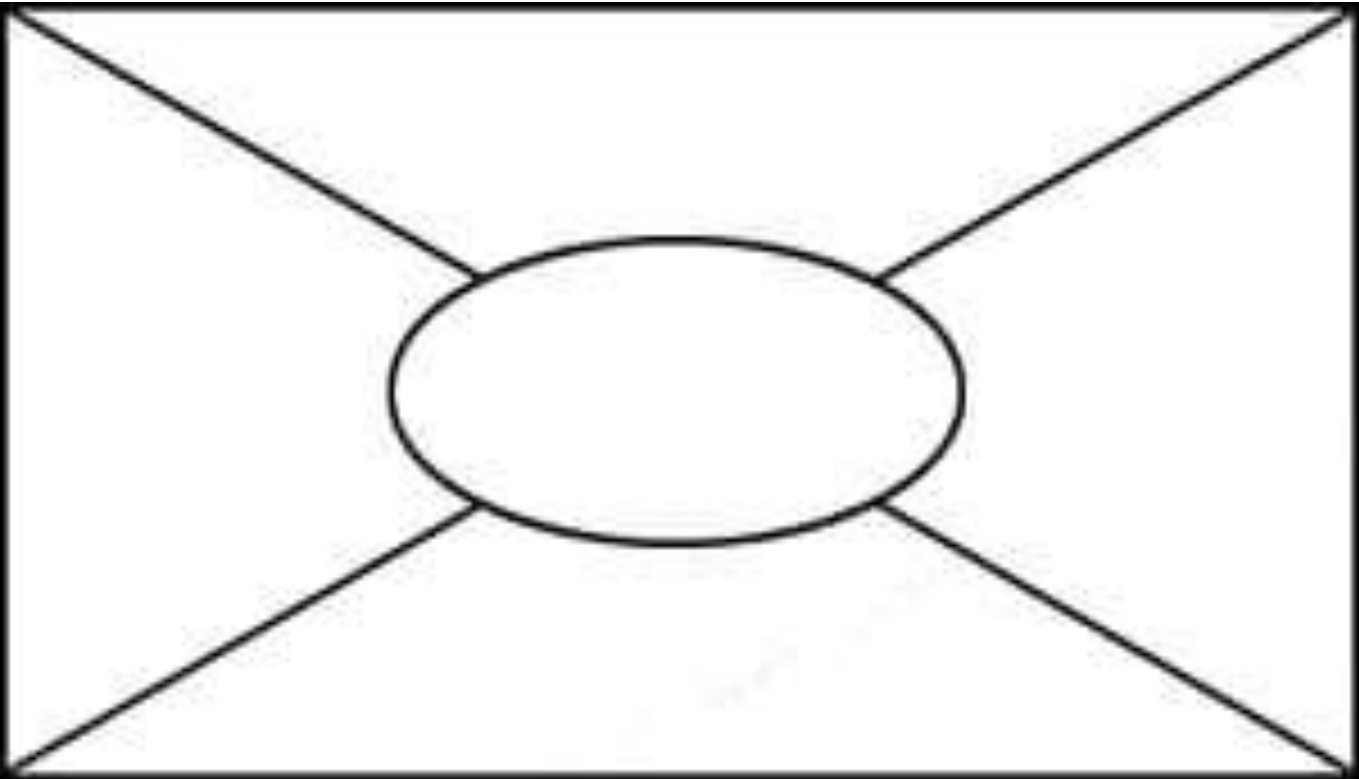

<p>DEFINITION: An external conflict That involves a mental or physical struggle between two Characters in a story.</p>	<p>DEFINITION: An internal conflict that involves the struggle between the character and his/her conscience /self.</p>	<p>DEFINITION: An external conflict that involves a struggle between the elements of nature that are beyond his/her control.</p>	<p>DEFINITION: An external conflict that involves the struggle between the character and the rules or laws that govern the society in which he/she lives.</p>
