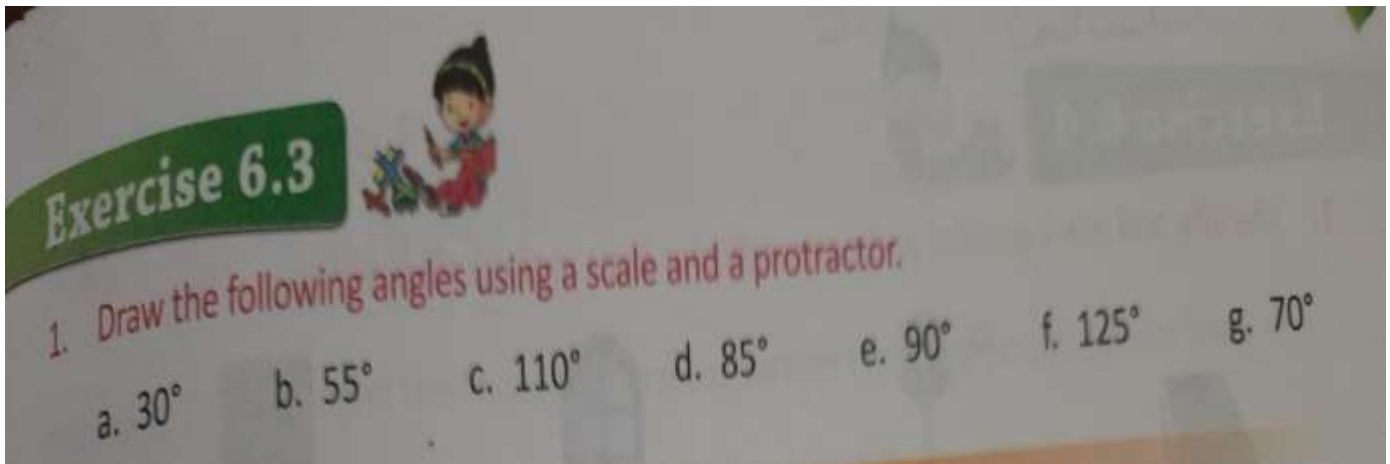

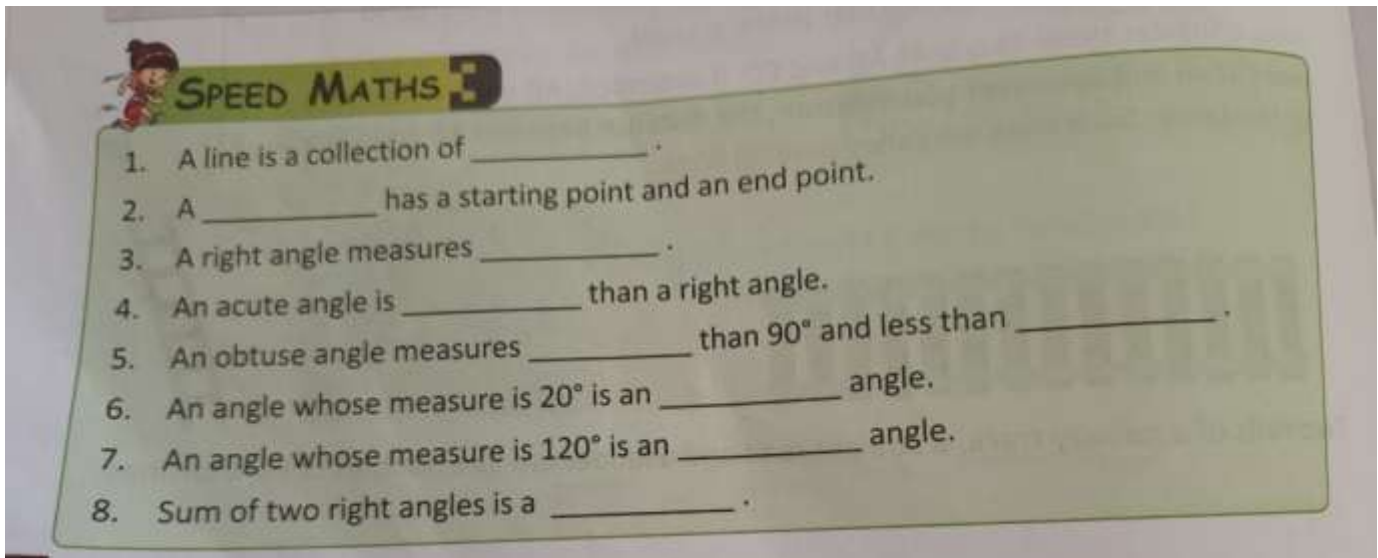

After the passing of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019, with effect from October 2019, India had 28 states and 9 union territories. In December, 2019, the union territories of Dadra and Nagar Haveli, and Daman and Diu were merged. India now has 28 states and 8 union territories. They are as follows:
